Thank you for consulting Cranford Parish Council on the Great Addington Neighbourhood Plan. Whilst the council is not directly impacted by this, it can identify some similarities between Great Addington and Cranford.

There are a couple of points which may need to be corrected, i.e.

In the Pre-Submission document 8.10 states Great Addington Parish Council is designated as an ACV.

This should probably read as Great Addington Memorial Hall is designated as an ACV

In the Design Guide 1.6 states Other nearby towns include Wellingborough and Rushton which are both to the south.

This should be Rushden not Rushton
